



Alex has a current WWVP registration. Their ex-spouse has reported them to child protection for **allegedly** hitting their child.



Alex contacted Access Canberra to inform them of the change in their circumstances.



Access Canberra investigated the case with child protection agencies. The allegations are proven to be true. No charges were laid by police.



Alex retains their WWVP registration but has restrictions placed upon it by Access Canberra.

What can Alex do now?



Alex can continue to work in regulated activities in accordance with the restrictions on their registration



Alex must tell Access Canberra about any further changes to their circumstances



Alex has conditions placed on their WWVP registration. The conditions may be reviewed when they next renew their registration.
